ADMISSION TO MASTER'S DEGREE STUDIES FOR NON-EU CITIZENS

Foreign citizens from non-European Union countries may be enrolled in study places either without tuition fees, benefiting from scholarships granted by the Romanian state, or on a tuition-fee basis, with fees paid in foreign currency.

According to Law no. 1/2010, the tuition fee for full-time Master's degree studies in the field of Cinematography and Media is 950 EUR per month.

The fee is charged for the entire duration of the academic year.

Pre-enrolment Conditions

Foreign citizens may apply for accredited Master's degree programmes provided that they cumulatively meet the following conditions:

- a) they hold documents certifying citizenship of a non-EU country;
- b) they are graduates of a Bachelor's degree programme or equivalent;
- c) they possess study documents issued by institutions recognized in their country of origin;
- d) they present the Letter of Acceptance to studies;
- e) they have passed the aptitude test or admission examination.

Application File

The application file must include:

- a) a fully completed Application Form for Non-EU Citizens requesting the issuance of the Letter of Acceptance;
- b) a copy of the document proving permanent residence abroad;
- c) a copy of the passport (first three pages), valid for at least six months from the start of the requested study programme;
- d) a birth certificate, accompanied by a certified translation into Romanian;
- e) a copy and certified Romanian translation of the high school diploma or equivalent, authenticated by the competent authorities in the issuing country;
- f) a copy and certified Romanian translation of the Bachelor's degree diploma or equivalent, authenticated by the competent authorities;
- g) academic transcripts or diploma supplements, in copy and certified Romanian translation;
- h) an English language proficiency certificate;

- i) a medical certificate, issued in an internationally recognized language, confirming that the candidate does not suffer from contagious diseases or conditions incompatible with the future profession;
- j) proof of name change, where applicable, in copy and certified Romanian translation;
- k) a copy and certified Romanian translation of the identity document;
- l) original study documents;
- m) consent for the processing of personal data;
- n) proof of payment of the application fee;
- o) and a portfolio specific to the chosen study programme.

Authentication of Documents

Original study documents issued in countries that are parties to the Hague Apostille Convention must bear the Hague Apostille applied by the competent authorities in the issuing country.

Documents issued in countries that are not parties to the Convention must be super-legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the issuing country and by the Romanian embassy or consular office in that country.

Incomplete application files will not be processed and will be rejected. The files of rejected candidates or those who withdraw their application will be returned within a maximum of 48 hours from the submission of the request, without additional fees.

Language Proficiency Certificate

For enrolment in Master's degree programmes taught in English, non-EU candidates are required to submit an English language proficiency certificate such as TOEFL, IELTS, or Cambridge.

Candidates from countries where English is the official language, and who can provide proof through educational documents that they have completed their studies in the language of instruction of the programme, are exempt from submitting such a certificate.

Admission Registration

Registration for the admission process is carried out through the 2bitsEDU online platform, accessible via the university website www.unatc.ro, under the Admission 2026 section.

The candidate's name must be entered exactly as it appears in the passport. After completing all sections and uploading the required documents, the system generates the application form. This form must be printed, signed, scanned, and uploaded back to the platform.

In order to obtain the status of a registered candidate for the 2026 summer admission session, the applicant must ensure that the application form has been correctly completed, all required documents have been uploaded, and that they have received by email the validation link and the unique participation code. The unique code is issued only if the application file is accepted. In the event of rejection, the candidate will receive an invalidation notification.

The admission examination will be conducted in accordance with the official schedule published by the university.

Enrolment

Enrolment in Master's degree studies is conditional upon passing the admission examination and obtaining the Letter of Acceptance issued by the Romanian Ministry of Education and Research. This letter certifies the acceptance of the foreign citizen for studies and is required for obtaining the long-stay visa for study purposes.

The Letter of Acceptance is valid only for the higher education institution for which it was issued, starting with the academic year for which it was granted and for the respective study cycle.

At enrolment, the names of foreign citizens will be recorded in all academic documents exactly as they appear in the passport. The same name will also be used on graduation documents, including the diploma and diploma supplement. Candidates must present a passport bearing a valid visa for “study purposes.”

Admitted foreign students will conclude a study contract with the university and will be registered in the faculty's academic records.

Obligations of Foreign Students

Foreign students are required:

- a) to comply with the Constitution and laws of Romania;
- b) the internal regulations of UNATC and the regulations governing student academic activity;
- c) as well as the provisions of the present regulation;
- d) they are also required to report to the General Inspectorate for Immigration within the Ministry of Internal Affairs in order to obtain a residence permit for the entire duration of their studies in Romania.
